**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL. A £25 deposit must accompany any objections within half an hour of the results being posted. The organizers, landowners and tenant accept no liability for any death, loss, damage, injury or illness to horse, rider, owner, spectator or any other person or property whatsoever, whether by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way. No jewellery allowed except a wedding ring, a stock pin or tie clip. No stopwatches allowed.

**NO DOGS.**

The course will be mapped at the start and is the responsibility of competitors to take their correct course, which will be open for walking on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> August 2011 from 2.30pm. Please do not walk the course before this time.

Competitors may continue at the judges discretion after being eliminated at a fence, but must give way to the following competitors. Fall of a horse/pony will result in compulsory retirement and the competitor must walk from the course dismounted. Second fall of rider will result in compulsory retirement. If there is any doubt as to the fitness of a competitor following a fall then the judge may ask them to retire.
